- 1. Older cats are already **litter box trained**. You won't have to go through the process of teaching a kitten how to use the box.
- 2. Older cats are **less likely to be rambunctious and mischievous**. They probably won't get into your plants, knock over your belongings or climb the curtains.
- 3. Older cats tend to be **mellower** and sleep more than kittens or young adults. An older cat will be happy to curl up in your lap while you work or watch TV.
- 4. Most older cats already understand what 'no" means.
- 5. Older cats are **good at giving love**, once they get into their new loving home. They are grateful for the second chance they've been given.
- 6. **What you see is what you get**: Unlike kittens, older cats have grown into their size, shape and personality. Kittens can grow up to be quite different from what they seemed at first.
- 7. Older cats **leave you time for yourself**, because they don't make the kinds of demands on your time and attention that kittens do.
- 8. Older cats **let you get a good night's sleep** because they're accustomed to human schedules and don't generally need nighttime feedings or comforting.
